The wording for the rules for the 100 Up competition is as follows:

Ladies' 100 Up

This competition is played using 4 woods each, with the first to 100 shots declared as winner.

Each end is scored with the closest wood to the jack at 4 shots, second closest 3 shots, third closest 2 shots and the fourth closest at 1 shot, no other woods score.

Should two bowls be 'tied' within the scoring woods, those bowls will not be allocated points. The next closest will be allocated the score e.g. 'A' has shot bowl and will receive four points; 'A' and 'B' have the next two bowls but they are tied, hence they will not be scored, but the next bowls thereafter will be allocated 3 points, then 2, then 1 in the usual way. Thus, each end scores a total of 10 points.

If both players achieve 100 points on the same end with scoring in the usual way, then the match is a tie, an extra end will then be played. The extra end is played to see who ever gets the shot to win the game.
